We have had a student diagnosed with Hand Foot and Mouth Disease.

Please check your child for these symptoms.

These are some facts about the disease from WebMD:

It is an illness that causes sores in or on the mouth, hands or feet and sometimes the buttocks and legs. The sores may be painful. The illness usually doesn't last more than a week or so. It is common in children, but can also occur in adults. It is highly contagious.

It is not the same as other diseases that have similar names: foot and mouth disease, hoof and mouth disease or mad cow disease. These diseases occur in animals.

It is easily spread during the first week by coughing, sneezing or touching infected objects and putting them in your mouth.

It usually takes 3 - 6 days to get symptoms which may include tiredness, fever, then sores and blisters in or on the mouth, hands, feet or buttocks. In some cases, a skin rash may appear before the blisters. The blisters may break open and crust over, but usually go away in a week or so.

A doctor can tell if your child has Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease by the symptoms and looking at the sores and blisters.

Children may not return to school for at least 4 days after the rash or blisters appear.

St. Anthony School Parents Club Meeting – March 9, 2016


Brandt Kreuscher (President) called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with opening prayer.
